- Duties may include: Leading or assisting with projects, writing and editing written text, designing informational materials, developing creative content, providing input on communications best practices and attending meetings.

Please note that with background checks, the hiring process may take 6-8 weeks. Graduate students must be enrolled full-time in a graduate program *leading to a master's or doctoral degree*. Students must be currently enrolled in at least 6 semester/9 quarter units, or determined to be a full-time student by an accredited college or graduate/technical program leading to an advanced degree, unless permanently disabled. Student Worker positions/employment work assignments must correspond to the student's declared degree. Hours are 10-20 hours/week and may not exceed 20 hours/week.
