- Building a Better Service Delivery System by participating actively in community activities and organizational/governmental meetings to collaborate on effective and accessible service delivery;
- Supporting Positive Choices by providing daily opportunities for Family Court involved moms, mads, and guardians to get the support and education needed to co-parent cooperatively;


