**Resolution in Support of Interfaith Shelter Network Partnership in the
County of San Diego's *Live Well San Diego Initiative***

WHEREAS, the health, safety and well-being of residents is of primary concern for the County of San Diego and on July 13, 2010, the San Diego County Board of Supervisors adopted the *Live Well San Diego* initiative to achieve the County's vision of safe, healthy and thriving communities; and

WHEREAS, the *Live Well San Diego* initiative is about uniting all sectors—business, schools, military and veterans organizations, community- and faith-based organizations, and all levels of government—in order to bring about positive change; and

WHEREAS, the mission of Interfaith Shelter Network is to enable those served toward self-sufficiency by providing emergency and transitional shelter, and resources to homeless individuals and families in the San Diego region; and

WHEREAS, the vision of Interfaith Shelter Network is to end homelessness in San Diego by coordinating efforts of partnerships including, congregations, social service agencies, and governmental programs; and

WHEREAS, Interfaith Shelter Network demonstrates the principles of *Live Well San Diego* through providing clients with safe and stable housing with access to social workers, transportation services and child care; and

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, the Interfaith Shelter Network Governing Board of Directors approves the partnership between the County of San Diego's *Live Well San Diego Program* and the Interfaith Shelter Network occurring on September 24, 2015.
