



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
**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF

BE IT RESOLVED THAT Community Research Foundation (CRF) wishes to lease new space for the Heartland Center Program at 460 N. Magnolia Ave. Suite 110, El Cajon, CA 92020.

BE IT RESOLVED THAT the terms of the new lease are a five year commitment for 8,124 rentable square feet, at \$1.55 per square foot, for a total monthly commitment of \$12,592.20 in year one, escalating by 3% each year, thereafter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to execute all lease documents related to this transaction.
