Wintriss Technical Schools, a 501(c)(3) not for profit public benefit institution, doing business as The League Of Amazing Programmers, is honored to be considered for inclusion in your list of outstanding Live Well San Diego recognized partners. We are the only the only school in San Diego that teaches professional level programming to kids starting in the 5th grade. The 5-year, after-school League program is accredited by UCSD Extension and leads to a professional certificate in programming which is accepted by most businesses for direct employment as an entry level programmer without the need for a college degree. Because of an acute shortage of programmers in this country, entry level programmers typically get salaries in the \$100K range.

The League's has been teaching kids in San Diego since 2006 and at present has 200 kids attending after-school and weekend classes. Our goal is to have 50% of our students from underserved neighborhoods. We presently have campuses at the Malcolm X Library, The San Diego Central library and in Carmel Valley and have 40% girls and underprivileged students. Children from underserved communities attend classes for free.
