3. To identify opportunities for collaboration through project development and promoting partner initiatives.



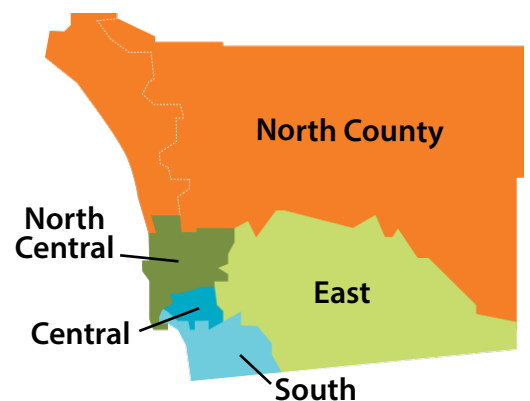
