WHAT ARE MEMORY SCREENINGS?

These brief tests check for possible problems with thinking and memory, which could be a sign of dementia or other memory-related issues. They are not used to diagnose, but can help determine if further evaluation by a healthcare provider is needed.

WHY ARE THEY IMPORTANT?

They can detect potential memory problems early, providing more time for individuals to make informed decisions about their care and participate in clinical trials, if desired.
